Boosters Grant Feature: Lev Sled



Findings based on new research into the long term dangers of sports-related concussions have forced many sports to evolve and change. Football is known for being a high-impact game and Duxbury High School football coach Dave Maimaron has been promoting player safety for eight years as coach of the Duxbury High School football team.

When players arrive for practice this season they will notice a massive new piece of equipment. A grant for a "Lev Sled" blocking sled was recently funded by the

Duxbury Boosters to replace a nearly 20-year old rusty relic from the days when players were taught to block with their shoulders and head. Today's high school football players are aware of the risks associated with concussions, and the potential for neurological impairment. The old sled was a safety hazard and did not function properly to fit the current style of play.

The new Lev Sled came with a price tag of seven thousand dollars, but to the Boosters it made perfect sense to replace the broken, outdated sled with a piece of equipment designed to encourage players to block with their hands. With



roughly 120 young men playing football at Duxbury High School this fall, the Lev Sled will be put to good use. Coach Maimaron says he is extremely grateful to the Boosters for funding this grant.

Joe Guilfoile, a Duxbury High School senior, who is also one of this year's captains, says the players are also very appreciative to the Boosters for their generosity.

"The linemen who will be using the Lev Sled will benefit the most, which in turn helps the entire team," says Guilfoile.

"Strength, Honor and Liberty" has become the motto of the Duxbury High School football team and Maimaron can't say enough about how proud he is of the kids he has had the opportunity to coach. Not only are they superior athletes, they are academic leaders who are a pleasure to coach.
